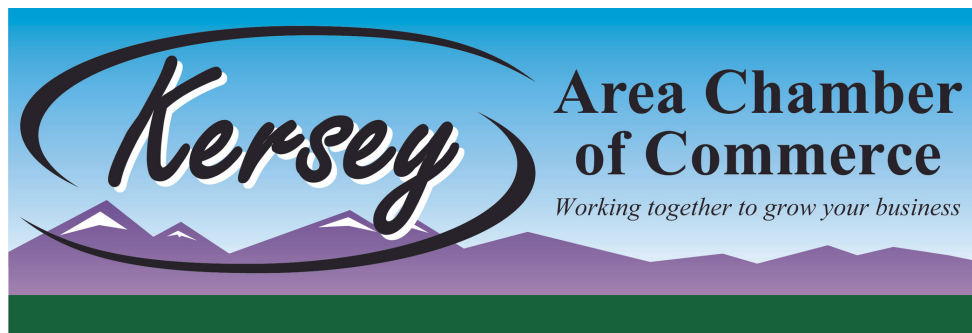

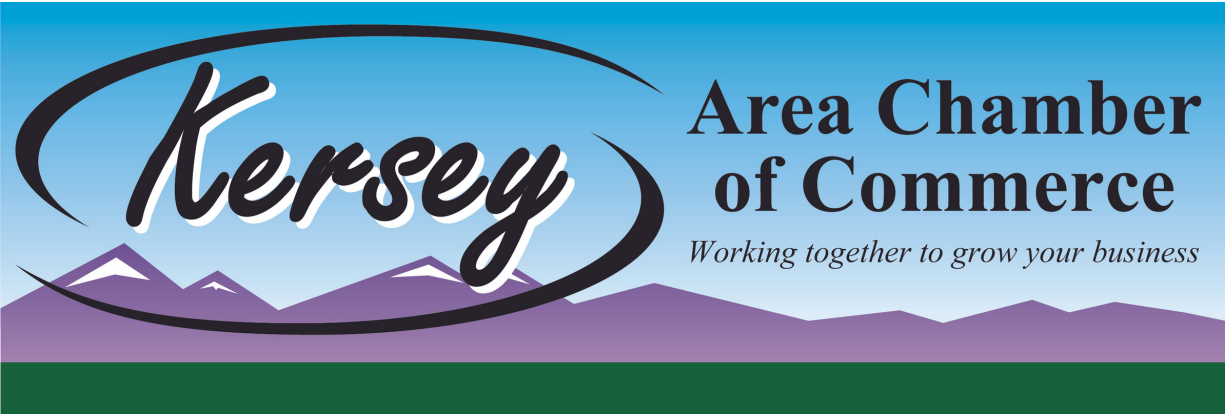
WE ARE HERE FOR YOU!
